The Workforce Pell Program expands access to federal Pell Grants for students enrolled in short-term education and training programs that prepare them for in-demand occupations. Delaware's newly released policy establishes the framework for certifying eligible programs and outlines the standards institutions of higher education must meet before programs can be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education for final approval.

SURVEY SHOWS FINANCIAL STRUGGLES FOR SMALL BUSINESSES IN OUR REGION

The Fed's Small Business Credit Survey shows evidence of major financial difficulties in 2025. Key findings include:

- Most firms in the DE, NJ, and PA described their financial condition as poor or fair. Debt levels held relatively steady, with over one-third of firms seeking loans or credit lines.
- Rising costs and operating expenses, and weak sales. Nearly half reported issues with uneven cash flows and tariff-related costs.
